Green Statement

In all school activities St Luke's will encourage and support children, staff, suppliers and visitors to consider best use of materials; minimise waste of all types; be economical with energy, heat, light and water and consider the impact of their activities on the school and its finances, on the community and on the wider global environment.

Keeping safe

1. We will only use the computers in the way we have been told, which includes not giving out personal information.
2. We will only log on to our own or our class accounts.
3. We will only go on the internet when we have been told we can and when we are being supervised by a grown up.
4. We will only go on the sites that we are supposed to and are to do with the subjects we are researching.
5. If we see something that is not suitable when we are using the internet (e.g. bad language, something rude) we will press the Hector Button and tell a teacher immediately.
6. We will not use mobile phones in school at all.
7. If we see or know of someone else breaking any of these rules we will tell a grown up.
